NDAA BACKGROUND

The John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2019 was signed into law on August 13, 2018. The law, specifically Section 889, prohibits federal agencies, their contractors and grant or loan recipients from procuring or using “telecommunications and video surveillance equipment or services” from specific Chinese companies as a “substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system.”

The NDAA ban includes telecommunications equipment produced by Huawei Technologies Company or ZTE Corporation, as well as video surveillance and telecommunications equipment produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company.

POSITION ON NDAA COMPLIANCE

TELTONIKA NETWORKS UAB hereby states that the LTE Cat 4 Router RUT956 is compliant with the NDAA, Section 889(a)(1)(A) and 889(a)(1)(B), and does not contain any banned “telecommunications equipment or services” from the above-mentioned vendors.
